## 5-Day Themed Day Camps

**June 28-July 2: Under the Big Top**—Join us as we explore the circus world. Walk a tight rope, swing on a trapeze and learn trick riding and vaulting on horseback.

**July 19-23: Digging for Gold**— explore with the cowboys and Indians of the west, as we go on an adventure to find gold! Treasure hunt and compete in an obstacle course on horseback.

**Aug. 2-6: Knights on Horseback**— make armor for your horse, joust, and explore the castle! Spend the week riding in medieval times.

All camp weeks include campers working with the horses everyday— feeding, grooming, saddling, and general care. Plus, ride for a hour everyday! Other activities include, games, crafts, swimming and more.

- Camp is for boys and girls, ages 6-16.
- Camp runs from 8:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m.
- All riding levels welcome! No experience necessary. English and Western Riding offered.
- Cost of camp is \$260 per week if registered and paid in full by May 1st.
- Cost of camp is \$285 per week if registered after May 1st.

## 3-Day Trail Ride and Swim Day Camps

**Session one —July 7-9    Session two—July 26-28**

Come and join us for a day on the trails, plus, a relaxing afternoon swim. For boys and girls ages 10-17.

Camp runs from 8:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m.

English and Western Riding. Must have riding experience and be proficient at a walk and trot/jog.

Campers arrive to help with the feeding of the animals on the farm, then they will catch their horses and saddle for approximately 3 hours on the trails. Campers will eat lunch on the trail and then return for an afternoon swim. Lastly, feed and bed down the horses for the night.

## Advanced Rider 5-Day Camp

**July 12-16:** 8:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m. Plus, join us for a sleepover Thursday night!

All new for this year! A camp just for those experience riders who want to expand their horse skills and knowledge. Come spend the week on the farm exploring all areas of riding. Work on jumping. Ride bareback. Barrel race. Take a trail ride and more. All riders will be assigned a horse for the week to work with on various riding disciplines. Spend 3 hours riding everyday. Plus, play games and go swimming.

Riders must have riding experience and be proficient at the walk, trot/jog and cater/lope. English and Western Riders welcome. Offered for boys and girls ages 10-17.

### What to bring to camp:

#### 3-Day Trail Ride and Swim Camps

Riding Clothing-

Pants— Jeans or riding pants are preferred, no shorts.

Boots— with a 1/2" to 1" heel. Absolutely no open toed or open heeled shoes.

Lunch— Bring a bagged lunch and bottled drinks. Campers will be carrying their lunch and drinks out on the trail. Lunch bag/box and drinks must fit in a 12" x13" bag.

Swim wear-Bathing suit/swimming trunks, Towel, sun-screen

\*Bug Repellent, \*riding helmet (if you have your own, if not they are available to borrow)

\*\*Rain Poncho (we will ride inside if steady rain, in the event of just a drizzle we may trail ride)

\*\* NO LUNCH NEEDED Wednesday! A pizza party will be provided.

#### 5-Day Themed Day Camps and Advanced Rider Day Camp

Riding Clothing- Pants— Jeans or riding pants are preferred, no shorts. Boots— with a 1/2" to 1" heel. Absolutely no open toed or open heeled shoes.

Lunch— Bring a bagged lunch, drinks and an afternoon snack will be provided.

Swim wear-Bathing suit/swimming trunks, Towel, sun-screen

Comfortable clothing— bring a change of clothes for playing games and doing other activities. May bring shorts, must have sneakers.

Bring: Sleeping bag and pillow.

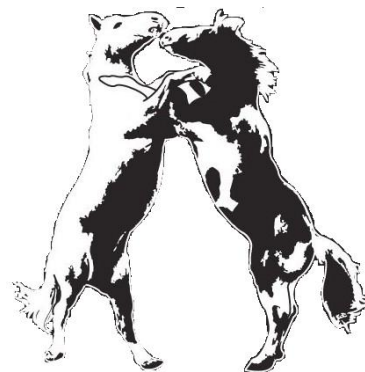
Change of clothes— including warm clothes for evening
